SECTION – I: INSTRUCTION FOR PREPARATION & SUBMISSION OF TENDER AND GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1.0** One copy of tender document should be sealed & signed as a token of acceptance of its terms and conditions and returned intact along with part-I of offer, (no page should be detached).
- 2.0** Tender must be submitted in two parts i.e. Techno - Commercial (Part – I) and Price Bid (Part – II). The tender should be packed in four sealed envelopes as elaborated below:
 - 2.1** **Sealed Envelop No. 1:-** This envelop should contain DD/PO towards the requisite Tender document fee & BID SECURITY as per provisions mentioned in the tender document. This sealed envelope should be subscribing “Tender document fee & BID SECURITY” against enquiry No. & date as mentioned above.

- 2.2** **Sealed Envelop No. 2:** This envelop should contain Part –I Techno-Commercial BID) as asked in the tender document. This sealed envelope should be subscribing Part-I of enquiry No. & date as mentioned above. There should be no indication of price in the Part- I of offer.
- 2.3** **Sealed Envelop No. 3 i.e. Part-II (PRICE BID)** : This envelop should contain only Price Part as per provisions mentioned in the tender. The sealed envelope should be superscripted PART – II (Price Part) of enquiry No. & date as mentioned above. No condition should be stipulated in this part, in case, if any, will be ignored.
- 2.4** **Sealed Envelop No. 4:** The above three sealed envelopes should be packed in another sufficiently large envelop to enable it to be opened without tearing the inner sealed envelopes. The outer cover should bear address of the authority who has invited tender and super-scribed there on enquiry No. & date as mentioned above, for supply of supply of Vimal make worsted Woolen Jerkin and the details of above mentioned three envelops. In case above mentioned pattern for submitting tender document is not followed by the tenderer, their tender is liable to be ignored.
- 3.0 DELIVERY OF TENDER:**
The submission and delivery of tenders within the specified date and time will be the sole responsibility of the Tenderer. In case the date of submission/opening of tender happens to be a holiday, than tenders may be submitted/opened on the next day up-to/at prescribed time.
- 3.1** **Late Tender:** The tenders received after specified due date & time of submission of tender will be treated as late tender and will not be considered at all. RSMML will not be responsible for delay in delivery of the tenders through post/speed post/courier/personal or any other means.
- 3.2** Tenderer should quote as far as possible in the form & pattern, as envisaged herein. It will help in making proper comparison & avoid any errors/emissions.
- 3.3** Tenders other than in the prescribed form and pattern described herein are liable to be ignored as it makes comparison difficult. Offers through Fax/e-mail /telegram will not be considered Printed conditions on the back of letters originating from Tenderer will be ignored.
- 4.0 EXCEPTIONS & DEVIATIONS:**
Tenderers are advised to submit their offer based on the terms & conditions and specifications contained in the tender document and not to stipulate any deviations. Offer containing stipulations of deviations to the terms & conditions are liable to be rejected. The tender will furnish the undertaking towards acceptance of specifications, all terms and conditions of tender in Annexure-IV.
- 5.0** Quotation qualified by such vague and indefinite expressions as "SUBJECT TO IMMEDIATE ACCEPTANCE" or "SUBJECT TO PRIOR SALE" is liable to be ignored.

6.0 Tenders containing corrections and alterations are liable to be rejected unless all such corrections and alterations are sealed and signed by the tenderer.

7.0 SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS:

The Tenderer should furnish the following supporting documents along with offer:

- i) Tender document fee, if down loaded from our website.
- ii) Demand Draft of Bid security in the manner specified in tender as per clause no. 14.0 of section -I.

8.0 BEFORE SUBMITTING TENDER:

Tenderer shall be deemed to have satisfied himself of all conditions liable to be encountered during the execution of the contract or rates quoted in the offer are adequate and all inclusive with respect to all factors circumstances and conditions likely to be incidental to the execution of the contract, as per the scope and conditions given herein.

9.0 SCHEDULE OF RATES:

- i) The tenderer is to offer most competitive rates as per annexure no. VIII.
- ii) The quoted price will remain firm and fixed till complete execution of the contract except changes in statutory duties/taxes by Govt., which are directly reflected in the invoice. The price must be net and must include delivery charges, if any. Price should be on f.o.r. destination basis i.e. corporate office, RSMML, 4-Meera Marg, Udaipur.
- iii) Tenderer should mention the rate of excise duty, CST/VAT or any other charges extra; the same must be specifically stated. In the absence of any such stipulation it will be presumed that the prices are inclusive of all such charges and no claim for the same will be entertained.

iv) Tenderer should not mention any conditions/deviation to the terms and conditions of tender in the price bid, if any same will be ignored.

10.0 PRICE VARIATION:

The quoted price shall remain firm and fixed till the complete execution of contract. Only variation on account of changes in Taxes & Duties by the Government will be considered on production of documentary proof. No escalation/ variation on any other grounds whatsoever shall be considered or be admissible.

Variations on Government Taxes & Duties: The tenderer/bidder will indicate in his offer the applicable percentage of Taxes & duties at the time of opening of offer. In the event of any increase/decrease in the Taxes & duties by the Government within the delivery period, directly reflecting in the invoice, the difference of the same shall be passed on to the Contractor/RSMML as the case may be. The subsequent increase shall be payable only on the production of authentic documentary proof by the Supplier.

Save and except as aforesaid, the tenderer shall not be entitled to raise any claim and/or demand and/or any dispute on account of escalation for increase in the prices of any other item or element.

11.0 AUTHORITY TO SIGN TENDER:

The tender should be signed by the person who is legally authorized to enter into commitments on behalf of the Tenderer.

12.0 OPENING OF TENDERS:

Tenders will be opened on the fixed date and time in the presence of Tenderer or their authorized representative who may wish to be present at the opening of the tender at the place, time and date as specified in the schedule.

13.0 VALIDITY:

The tenderer shall keep the offer open for acceptance by RSMML for a minimum period of four months from the date of opening of tender within which period the tenderer shall have no right to withdraw, amend or modify his offer. In case of withdrawal/amendment/modification the earnest money deposited by the Tenderer, as per clause No.17 hereof shall stand forfeited. This validity period may be extended further if required by mutual consent from time to time.

In case, tenderer, after issuance of communication of acceptance of offer by RSMML, fails to execute the contract as per the conditions of the contract, such an event will be considered as the tenderer calculated willful breach of the contract, the cost & consequence of which shall be on the sole account of the tenderer. Moreover, RSMML have full right to claim damages thereof in addition to the forfeiture of BID SECURITY.

14.0 BID SECURITY:

The tenderer shall deposit (interest free) a sum of **Rs.6, 830/-** (Rs. Six thousand eight hundred thirty only) as Bid security along-with the tender by Demand Draft/Banker's Pay order. It should be in favour of RSMML payable at Udaipur. Offers not accompanied with the Bid

security will not be considered. Cheque or Bank Guarantee will not be accepted towards BID SECURITY.

14.1 The BID Security shall be forfeited in the following cases:

- a. If the tenderer cancels, withdraws amends or modifies the offer on its own after submission of tender.
- b. If the tenderer does not submit the prescribed security deposit cum performance guarantee.
- c. If it is established that tenderer has submitted any wrong information/forged document along-with the tender or thereafter.
- d. If the tenderer declines to accept the order placed by the Company, subsequent to acceptance of his offer.
- e. If the tenderer breaches any provision of code of integrity prescribed for bidders as per Annexure- B.

14.2 Bid security of unsuccessful tenderer will be refunded after finalization of tender/validity of the offer has expired. The bid security of successful tenderer will be refunded after receipt of Security Deposit cum performance guarantee as per contract.

14.3 The Bid security of a tenderer lying with the company in respect of other tenders awaiting approval or rejected or on account of contract completed will not be adjusted towards Bid security deposit for the fresh tenders. However, the Bid security originally deposited may be taken into consideration in case tenders are re-invited.

14.4 In case of participation by Undertakings, Corporations, Autonomous Bodies which are controlled and managed by Govt., Govt. Undertakings and Companies of Union Govt. & Govt. of Rajasthan, they are exempted from deposition of Bid security.

14.5 Except above, no Bid security exemption will be given to any party on any grounds and their offer will liable for exemption.

15.0 NEGOTIATIONS:-

- i) Negotiations will be conducted with the lowest tenderer only. In case of non-satisfactory achievement of rates from lowest tenderer, RSMML may choose to make a written counter offer to the lowest tenderer and if this is not accepted, RSMML may decide to reject and re-invite fresh tenders or to make the same counter-offer first to the second lowest tenderer, then to the third lowest tenderer and so on in the order of initial bidding, and work order be awarded to the tenderer who accepts the counter offer.
- ii) In the case, when the quotations given by the tenderer during negotiations is higher than the original quotation of the tenderer then the tenderer will be bound by the lower rate originally quoted by the tenderer.

- iii) In case of negotiations, representative of the tenderer attending negotiations must possess written authority from the tenderer to the effect that he is competent to modify/amend the submitted tender deviations and rates offered by them.
- iv) In the event the company does not find the lowest quoted rate, acceptable to it, then the tender will be scrapped and may be re-invited, or company may take any other suitable action as deemed fit looking to the exigency of the work.

16.0 TERMINATION:

- a. In case of failure of tenderer to perform the job as required under this tender or observe breach of any of the terms and conditions by the tenderer, the company shall give a notice to rectify the default or breach within 10 days. Failure to rectify such default/ breach may result into termination of the contract and forfeiture of security deposit without any prejudice to the company's rights to claim damages/costs/loss etc caused by such default / breach. Such termination shall not absolve the supplier from the liabilities accruing till the date of such termination.
- b. The contract may also be terminated in the event the supplier is being adjudged insolvent or going into Liquidation or Winding up of their business, or making arrangement with their creditors.
- c. Notwithstanding anything contained herein above, the company in its absolute discretion may at any time terminate the order without assigning any reason thereof by giving Fifteen day's notice to the supplier at their last notified address. In such an event the supplier shall not be entitled to raise any claim or demand for compensation, loss of profit and/or damages and / or losses or costs by reason of such earlier termination on any ground whatsoever.

17.0 FORCE MAJEURE:

If at any time, during the continuance of the contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party (sub-vendors excluded) and/or obligations under this contract shall be prevented or delayed by reason of any war, Hostility acts of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosion, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, non-performance due to Acts of God or Acts of Government /statutory bodies (herein after referred as "Event") then provided a notice of the happening of any such event is given within seven days from the date of occurrence thereof neither party shall by reason of such event be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damage against the other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance and the deliveries and/or performance of the work under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such event has come to an end or ceased to exist and decision of Company as to whether the deliveries and/or performance of the work have been so resumed or not shall be final and conclusive. Provided further that if the

performance in whole or in part is delayed by reasons of any such events for a period exceeding thirty days either party may at its option terminate the contract.

18. JURISDICTION :

The contract is subject to the jurisdiction of courts at Udaipur in the state of Rajasthan.

SECTION –II: SPECIAL CONCIDITIONS OF CONTRACT:

2.1 SPECIFICATION & QUANTITY:

Detailed technical Specification of the required Woollen Jerkins are as under:

 4. The samples will be selected before opening of price bid & more than one sample can be selected for it.
 5. RSMML at its sole discretion may or may not select the sample of Jerkin of any of the tenderer. No claim on this ground will be admissible/entertained.

2.2 SCOPE OF SUPPLY:

- A. The scope of supply shall be the supply of Woollen jerkins in different sizes to RSMML, Corporate office, 4-Meera Marg, Udaipur, in accordance with the agreed specifications, terms and conditions.
- B. The supplier shall be entirely responsible for the performance of the contract in all respects.

2.3 DELIVERY PERIOD:

Tenderer should state the minimum possible delivery period for supply of stores. The delivery of the stores is required on f.o.r. destination basis.

2.4 GUARANTEE:

- a) The Jerkin shall be guaranteed for a period of one year from the date of satisfactory supply of stores against colour, texture & quality. The cloth should not have any tendency of shrinkage, fading of colour etc. The quality, colour, aesthetic look, lining, Zip (chain) button, stitching etc. of Jerkin should be similar to the sample approved by RSMML.
- b) In case of any difference in the quality, the same shall be liable to be rejected and tenderer shall replace the same free of cost within fifteen days from the date of issue of rejection note. In case, at any point of time, during one year from the date of supply any defect in the quality of Jerkin is found, the same will be replaced by you at your risk and cost.
- c) It at any time during the guarantee period, the stores do not conform to the Company's requirement/specifications and/or do not meet the desired performance, tenderer will rectify and replace the stores as the case may be in a manner calculated by him to correct the deficiency at his expenses within the minimum time to be specified by the Company. In the event tenderer fails to do so, the Company shall take appropriate action and the expenses on this account forthwith be reimbursed by the tenderer without prejudice to the Company's right and/or remedies provided in the contract or by the relevant provision of Law.

2.5 DELIVERY BASIS: On 'Door delivery' basis to our corporate office, Udaipur.

2.7 RATES:

- i) The prices to be quoted in separate sealed cover as per Performa enclosed herewith, (Price bid - Part II), Annexure-**VIII**, (There should be no enclosure with the price bid). In case tenderer is offering more than one sample with different prices, then, they are requested to furnish the prices of each sample in separate sealed cover superscribing price bid for sample A, sample B etc.
- ii) Single price should be offered for all sizes of Jerkins.
- iii) The quoted rate shall remain firm & fixed during the complete execution of the contract. Only the variation on account of price variation clause No. 2.8 will be considered or be admissible.
- iv) The charges towards duties, taxes, levies or any other charges as applicable for the supply of Jerkins must be stated specifically. In the absence of any such stipulation it will be presumed that the price includes all such charges and no claim whatsoever for the same will be entertained.

- v) The price quoted should be both in figures and in words. In case of any discrepancy between the figures and written words, the lower of the two shall be taken as the quoted price for comparison.
- vi) Entries should be neat and legible without any correction. Corrections, if any, must be signed in full with date.

2.8 PRICE VARIATION:

- i) The price shall remain firm and fixed till the complete execution of the contract. Only variation on account of changes in Taxes & Duties by the Government which are directly reflected in the invoice will be considered on production of documentary proof provided that the variation take place within the scheduled delivery period.
- ii) Save and except as aforesaid, the supplier shall not be entitled to raise any claim and/or demand and/or any dispute on account of escalation or raise or increase in the prices of any other item or element.

2.9 INSURANCE:

The tenderer shall insure the stores against all transit risk from warehouse to warehouse basis at his own cost.

2.10 TERMS OF PAYMENT & PAYING AUTHORITY:

- i) 100% Payment within 30 days after receipt and acceptance of stores by consignee.
- ii) **Billing & Paying Authority:**
The bill in triplicate alongwith the supporting documents duly verified by the consignee will be released by Payment disbursing authority **-FA, RSMML, CO.**
- iii) Payment will be made through RTGS. All bank charges/commission shall be borne by the contractor.

2.11 RSMML RIGHT:

The Company reserves to exercise the following rights at its sole discretion without assigning any reasons thereof. The decision of the Company in this regard shall be final and binding:

- i) to accept any offers or reject any or all the offers.
- ii) to cancel the tender, postpone it for another date, change the venue of the receipt of the tender.
- iii) to increase/decrease the quantity at any time.
- iv) to change the sizes of Jerkins.
- v) to divide the quantity into more than one tenderer .
- vi) to select/not to select the sample of any tenderer on technical ground.

2.12 DETERMINATION OF LOWEST BIDDER:

- a. The lowest tenderer among the established makes at our mines shall be determined on the basis of total landed cost of the offered Woolen

Jerkin inclusive of all duties, taxes, transportation charges etc and giving effect of any other duties/taxes levied/exempted/input credit on VAT by State/Central Govt. which are applicable directly / indirectly on the supply/use of AOS. On similar basis L2, L3, L4,..... Tenderers will be determined.

- b. While tabulating the bids of those firms which are not entitled to price preference, the element of Rajasthan Value Added Tax shall be excluded from the rates quoted by the firms of Rajasthan and the element of Central Sales Tax shall be included in the rates of firms from outside Rajasthan for evaluation purpose.
- c. In case RSMML opt for placing the purchase order to more than one tenderer, then initially L2 tenderer will be extended opportunity to match L1 rate after giving effect, as above, i.e. input credit of VAT, on refusal by L2 tenderer, then to L3 tenderer & so on.
- d. In the event the company does not find the lowest quoted rate, acceptable to it, then the tender will be scrapped and may be re-invited, or company may take any other suitable action as deemed fit looking to the exigency of the work.

2.13 SECURITY DEPOSIT CUM PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE:

- ii) If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of sub totals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and
- iii) If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to (i) and (ii) above.
If the Bidder that submitted the lowest evaluated bid does not accept the correction of errors, its bid shall be disqualified and its Bid Security shall be forfeited or its Bid Securing Declaration shall be executed.

1. Procuring Entity's Right to Vary Quantities

- (i) At the time of award of contract, the quantity of Goods, works or services originally specified in the Bidding Document may be increased or decreased by a specified percentage, but such increase or decrease shall not exceed twenty percent, of the quantity specified in the Bidding Document. It shall be without any change in the unit price or other terms and conditions of the bid and the conditions of contract.
- (ii) If the Procuring Entity does not procure any subject matter of procurement or procures less than the quantity in the Bidding Document due to change in circumstances, the bidder shall not be entitled for any claim or compensation except otherwise provided in the conditions of contract .
- (iii) In case of procurement of goods or services, additional quantity may be procured by placing a repeat order on the rates and conditions of the original order. However, the additional quantity shall not be more than 25% of the value of goods of the original contract and shall be within one month from the date of expiry of last supply. If the supplier fails to do so, Procuring Entity shall be free to arrange for the balance supply by limited bidding or otherwise and the extra cost incurred shall be recovered from the supplier.

2. Dividing quantities among more than one bidder at the time of award (In case of procurement of goods)

As a general rule all the quantities of the subject matter of procurement shall be procured from the bidder, whose bid is accepted. However, when it is considered that the quantity of the subject matter of procurement to be procured is very large and it may not be in the capacity of the bidder, whose bid is accepted, to deliver the entire quantity or when it is considered that the subject matter of procurement to be procured is of critical and vital nature, in such cases, the quantity may be divided between the bidder, whose bid is accepted and the second lowest bidder or even more bidders in that order, in a fair, transparent and equitable manner at the rates of the bidder, whose bid is accepted.
