DETAILED NOTICE INVITING TENDER

Sealed tenders in two parts (Part-I, Techno-commercial part & Part-II, Price part) are invited from Manufacturer or their authorized dealer/distributor for supply of Leather Safety Shoes for Industrial Personnel (Men & Women) having direct moulded sole, non metallic fiber reinforced light weight protective toe cap as per clause no.2.4.2 of DGMS approval no.04 dated 14.08.2014 or Confirming to IS 15298 Part – 2: 2011 in assorted sized, to be offered on sample basis.

RSMML will qualify and judge the techno-commercial suitability of the offers & short list the tenderer for price bid opening, based on selection of samples of the shoes furnished by the tenderer as per Company's requirement, documents furnished in line with the tender requirement and/ or information gathered by RSMML about the tenderer. The price bid (part-II of tender) of only techno-commercially acceptable tenderer will be opened on later date, which will be informed separately to the qualified tenderer only. The decision of the company in this regard shall be final and binding on both.

The tenderer who have earlier been suspended or banned by the company shall not be eligible to participate in this tender during the currency of suspension/ban period.

The tender documents consist of following:

SECTION - I: INSTRUCTION FOR PREPARATION & SUBMISSION OF TENDER:

- One set of tender document is sent herewith, copy of which should be sealed & signed as a token of acceptance for its terms and conditions and returned intact, (no page should be detached).
- 2.1 Tender must be submitted in two parts i.e. Techno Commercial (Part I) and Price Bid (Part II). The tender should be packed in four sealed envelopes as elaborated below. Each Envelop should be super scribed tender no. as mentioned above.
 - i) **Sealed Envelop No. 1:-** This envelop should contain DD/PO/BC towards requisite Tender document fee & Bid Security as per provisions mentioned

in the tender document. The envelop should be super scribed Tender document fee & Bid Security towards tender No. (as mentioned above).

- ii)) Sealed Envelop No. 2: This envelop should contain Part –I: Techno-Commercial BID alongwith all supporting documents (except DDs / POs / BCs towards tender document fee & the Bid Security & Price Bid) as asked in the tender document. This sealed envelope should be super scribed Part I of tender No (as mentioned above). The tenderer / bidder should give a declaration with Part 1 of the offer that they have not been banned/suspended or de-listed by RSMML. If this declaration is not given, the bid will be treated as non responsive.
- iii) **Sealed Envelop No. 3** i.e. Part-II (PRICE BID): This envelop should contain only Price Part as per provisions mentioned in the tender. The sealed envelope should be super scribed PART II (Price Part) of Tender No. (as mentioned above). No condition should be stipulated in this part, if any, shall be ignored.
- iv) **Sealed Envelop No. 4:** The above three sealed envelopes should be packed in another sufficiently large envelop to enable it to be opened without tearing the inner sealed envelopes. The outer cover should bear address of the authority who has invited tender and superscribed there on Tender No (as mentioned above) and the details of above mentioned three envelops.

In case above mentioned pattern for submitting tender document is not followed by the tenderer, their offer will be liable to be ignored.

3.0 DELIVERY OF TENDER:

The submission and delivery of tenders within the specified date and time will be the sole responsibility of the Tenderer. In case the date of submission / opening of tender happens to be a holiday, then date and time of submission and opening will be extended for one day.

3.1 **Late Tender:** The tenders received after specified date & time of submission of tender will be treated as late tender and will not be considered at all.

RSMML will not be responsible for delay in delivery of the tenders through post/speed post/courier/personal or any other means.

Tenderer should quote as far as possible in the form & pattern, as envisaged herein. It will help in making proper comparison & avoid any errors/omissions.

Tenders other than in the prescribed form and pattern described herein are liable to be ignored as it makes comparison difficult. Offers through Fax/e-mail /telegram will not be considered

Printed conditions on the back of letters originating from Tenderer will be ignored.

4.0 EXCEPTIONS & DEVIATIONS:

Tenderers are advised to submit their offer based on the terms & conditions and specifications contained in the tender document and not to stipulate any deviations. Offer containing stipulations of deviations to the terms & conditions are liable to be rejected. The tender will furnish the undertaking towards

acceptance of specifications, all terms and conditions of tender in Annexure-IV.

- Quotation qualified by such vague and indefinite expressions as "SUBJECT TO IMMEDIATE ACCEPTANCE" or "SUBJECT TO PRIOR SALE" is liable to be ignored.
- 6.0 Tenders containing corrections and alterations are liable to be rejected unless all such corrections and alterations are sealed and signed by the tenderer.

7.0 SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS:

The Tenderer should furnish the following supporting documents along with offer:

- i) DDs towards Tender document fee, if down loaded from our website /copy of cash receipt in case of purchases from our office.
- ii) Demand Draft towards Bid Security in the manner specified in tender as per clause no. 15.0.
- iii) Copy of complete tender document as issued duly filled and sealed & signed on each page by the tenderer as token of acceptance of specification, terms & conditions of tender

8.0 BEFORE SUBMITTING TENDER:

Tenderer shall be deemed to have satisfied himself of all conditions liable to be encountered during the execution of the contract or rates quoted in the offer are adequate and all inclusive with respect to all factors circumstances and conditions likely to be incidental to the execution of the contract, as per the scope and conditions given herein.

9.0 SCHEDULE OF RATES:

- i) The tenderer is to offer most competitive rates as per annexure no. VIII.
- ii) In case, tenderer is offering for more than one type of shoe, then they should furnish the Price Bid for each type of shoes separately super scribing "Price Bid offer for Make"

iii) The quoted price will remain firm and fixed till complete execution of the contract except changes in statutory duties/taxes by Govt., which are directly reflected in the invoice. - iv) Tenderer should mention the rate of excise duty, CST/VAT or any other charges extra; the same must be specifically stated. In the absence of any such stipulation it will be presumed that the prices are inclusive of all such charges and no claim for the same will be entertained.
- v) Tenderer should not mention any conditions/deviation to the terms and conditions of tender in the price bid, if any same will be ignored.

10.0 PRICE VARIATION:

- i) The price shall remain firm and fixed till the complete execution of the contract. Only variation on account of changes in ED/CST/VAT by the Government which are directly reflected on Tenderer's invoice will be considered on production of documentary proof provided that the variation take place within the scheduled delivery period.
- ii) Save and except as aforesaid, the supplier shall not be entitled to raise any claim and/or demand and/or any dispute on account of escalation or raise or increase in the prices of any other item or element.

11.0 TAXES, DUTIES & LEVIES:

a) The rate of Sales Tax as applicable (i.e. CST/VAT) in respect of each item of stores must be indicated. Wherever State/Central Sales Tax concession is applicable and relevant ST form is required to be issued by the company, it

should be indicated. The tenderer, if availing any incentive to the taxes and duties, should mention the same in the offer and provide supportive document.

b) The effect of all the taxes/duties/levies/entry tax on interstate sale/input tax credit on VAT/service tax etc. applicable directly or indirectly on supply of Indusrial leather Safety Shoes will be given while computing the total landed cost at destination.

c) EXCISE DUTY

The rate of Excise Duty, if applicable, should be specified against the item of stores to which it applies. Wherever concessions, if any, are available they should also be indicated.

- d) Any other tax, duties or levies by any name or form should be indicated in similar manner as in (a) and (b) above. The firms availing any incentive should mention in the tender.
- e) In the absence of clear stipulation stated above, it will be understood that except the quoted price all levies/duties are to the account of Tenderer.

12.0 AUTHORITY TO SIGN TENDER:

The tender should be signed by the person who is legally authorized to enter into commitments on behalf of the Tenderer.

13.0 OPENING OF TENDERS:

Tenders will be opened on the fixed date and time in the presence of Tenderer or their authorized representative who may wish to be present at the opening of the tender at the place, time and date as specified in the schedule.

14.0 VALIDITY:

The tenderer shall keep the offer open for acceptance by RSMML for a minimum period of four months days from the date of opening of tender within which period the tenderer shall have no right to withdrawn, amend or modify his offer. In case of withdrawal/amendment/ modification the earnest money deposited by the Tenderer, as per clause No.16 hereof shall stand forfeited. This validity period may be extended further if required by mutual consent from time to time.

In case, tenderer, after issuance of communication of acceptance of offer by RSMML, fails to execute the contract as per the conditions of the contract, such an event will be considered as the tenderer calculated willful breach of the contract, the cost & consequence of which shall be on the sole account of the tenderer. Moreover, RSMML have full right to claim damages thereof in addition to the forfeiture of Bid Security.

15.0 BID SECURITY:

a) The tenderer shall deposit (interest free) a sum of **Rs 43,500/- (Rupees Forty three thousand and five hundred only**) as Bid Security along with the tender by Demand Draft/PO. It should be in favour of RSMML

payable at Udaipur. Offers not accompanied with the requisite will not be considered. Bid Security in any manner other than DD/PO will not be accepted.

b) While opening of the tender, the envelope containing BID SECURITY will be opened first and in case the same is found as per tender requirement, then only the sealed envelope containing part-I & part- II of offer will be opened. The offer of the tenderer(s) who has not furnished Bid Security of requisite amount and in prescribed manner will not be considered.

c) The BID SECURITY shall be forfeited in case of:

- i) If tenderer unsolicited revises and/or modifies and/or withdraw and/or amend and/or cancel their tender at its own after prescribed due date and time of submission of tender.
- ii) If it is established that tenderer have submitted any wrong information/forged document along with the tender or thereafter/found indulge in unfair trade practices.
- iii) If the tenderer declines to accept contract/order placed by the Company subsequent to acceptance of his offer.
- iv) If the tenderer does not submit the security deposit cum performance guarantee.
- v) If the tenderer breaches any provision of code of integrity prescribed for bidder as detailed at Annexure –A.
- (d) The Bid Security furnished by the unsuccessful tenderers will be refunded after finalization of tender / validity of the offer has expired. Bid Security of successful tenderer will be refunded after receipt of Security Deposit cum performance guarantee.
- (e) The Bid Security of a tenderer lying with the company in respect of other tenders awaiting approval or rejected or on account of contract completed will not be adjusted towards earnest money deposit against this tender, however, the earnest money originally deposited may be taken into consideration in case tender is re-invited.
- (f) In case of participation by Undertakings, Corporations, Autonomous Bodies which are controlled and managed by Govt., Govt. Undertakings and Companies of Union Govt. & Govt. of Rajasthan, they are exempted from deposition of Earnest Money.
- (g) Bid Security will be taken @25% of the total value of Bid Security of tender in case of participation by SSI unit of Rajasthan subject to that the tenderer has participated against the tender in a capacity of manufacturer of offered product.
- (h) In case any tenderer is offering the quantity lesser than the tendered quantity, then they can submit proportionate amount of bid security in proportion to the quantity being offered with respect to the bid security amount for tender quantity.
- (i) Except above, no Bid Security exemption will be given to any party on any grounds and their offer will liable for rejection.

16.0 NEGOTIATIONS:

i) Negotiations will be conducted with the lowest tenderer only. In case of nonsatisfactory achievement of rates from lowest tenderer, RSMML may choose to make a written counter offer to the lowest tenderer and if this is not accepted, RSMML may decide to reject and re-invite fresh tenders or to make the same counter-offer first to the second lowest tenderer, then to the third lowest tenderer and so on in the order of initial bidding, and work order be awarded to the tenderer who accepts the counter offer.

- ii) In the case, when the quotations given by the tenderer during negotiations is higher than the original quotation of the tenderer then the tenderer will be bound by the lower rate originally quoted by the tenderer.
- iii) In case of negotiations, representative of the tenderer attending negotiations must possess written authority from the tenderer to the effect that he is competent to modify/amend the submitted tender deviations and rates offered by them.
- iv) In the event the company does not find the lowest quoted rate, acceptable to it, then the tender will be scrapped and may be re-invited, or company may take any other suitable action as deemed fit looking to the exigency of the work.

17.0 TERMINATION:

- a. In case of failure of tenderer to perform the job as required under this tender or observe breach of any of the terms and conditions by the tenderer, the company shall give a notice to rectify the default or breach within 10 days. Failure to rectify such default/ breach may result into termination of the contract and forfeiture of security deposit without any prejudice to the company's rights to claim damages/costs/loss etc caused by such default / breach. Such termination shall not absolve the supplier from the liabilities accruing till the date of such termination.
- b. The contract may also be terminated in the event the supplier is being adjudged insolvent or going into Liquidation or Winding up of their business, or making arrangement with their creditors.
- c. Notwithstanding anything contained herein above, the company in its absolute discretion may at any time terminate the order without assigning any reason thereof by giving Fifteen day's notice to the supplier at their last notified address. In such an event the supplier shall not be entitled to raise any claim or demand for compensation, loss of profit and/or damages and / or losses or costs by reason of such earlier termination on any ground whatsoever.

18.0 **FORCE MAJEURE:**

If at any time, during the continuance of the contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party (sub-vendors excluded) and/or obligations under this contract shall be prevented or delayed by reason of any war, Hostility acts of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosion, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, non-performance due to Acts of God or Acts of Government /statutory bodies (herein after referred as "Event") then provided a notice of the happening of any such event is given within **seven days** from the date of occurrence thereof neither party shall by reason of such event be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damage against the other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance and the deliveries and/or performance of

the work under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such event has come to an end or ceased to exist and decision of Company as to whether the deliveries and/or performance of the work have been so resumed or not shall be final and conclusive. Provided further that if the performance in whole or in part is delayed by reasons of any such events for a period exceeding **thirty days** either party may at its option terminate the contract.

19.0 **JURISDICTION:** The contract is subject to the jurisdiction of exclusive courts at Udaipur in the state of Rajasthan only.

2.3 SCOPE OF SUPPLY:

The scope of supply shall be the supply of shoes in different sizes in accordance with the agreed specifications, terms and conditions to respective destination.

The supplier shall be entirely responsible for the performance of the contract in all respects.

2.4 DELIVERY PERIOD:

Tenderer should state the minimum possible delivery period for supply of stores.

2.5. GUARANTEE:

- a) Guarantee should be applicable in respect of sub- standard material, Poor workmanship and manufacturing defects (excluding normal wear and tear) for a period of 12 months from the date of receipt and acceptance of the material at site. Defective material should be replaced free of cost within the period of 15 days of receipt of the complaint by the supplier.
- b) In case of any difference in the quality, the same shall liable to be rejected and tenderer shall replace the same free of cost within fifteen days from the date of issue of rejection note. In case, at any point of time, during 12 months from the date of of receipt and acceptance of the material at site any defect in the quality of shoes is found, the same will be replaced by you at your risk and cost.
- c) It at any time during the guarantee period, the stores do not conform to the Company's requirement/specifications and/or do not meet the desired

performance, tenderer will rectify or replace the stores as the case may be to correct the deficiency at his expenses within the minimum time to be specified by the Company. In the event tenderer fails to do so , the Company shall take appropriate action and the expenses on this account forthwith be reimbursed by the tenderer without prejudice to the Company's right and/or remedies provided in the contract or by the relevant provision of Law.

Provided further that in case a Procuring Entity evaluates the technical bids before the opening of the financial Bids, an appeal related to the matter of Financial Bids may be filed only by a Bidder whose Technical Bid is found to be acceptable.

- 1) The officer to whom an appeal is filed under para (1) shall deal with the appeal as expeditiously as possible and shall endeavour to dispose it of within thirty days from the date of the appeal.
- If the officer designated under para (1) fails to dispose of the appeal filed within the period specified in para (2) or if the Bidder or prospective bidder or the Procuring Entity is aggrieved by the order passed by the First Appellate Authority, the bidder or prospective bidder or the Procuring Entity, as the case may be, may file a second appeal to Second Appellate Authority specified in the Bidding Document in this behalf within fifteen days from the expiry of the period specified in para (2) or of the date of receipt of the order passed by the First Appellate Authority, as the case may be.

3) Appeal not to lie in certain cases

No appeal shall lie against any decision of the Procuring Entity relating to the following matters, namely:-

- vi) Determination of need of procurement;
- vii) Provisions limiting participation of Bidders in the Bid process;
- viii) The decision of whether or not to enter into negotiations;
- ix) Cancellation of a procurement process;
- x) Applicability of the provisions of confidentiality.

4) Form of Appeal

a) An appeal under para (1) or (3) above shall be in the annexed form alongwith as many copies as there are respondents in the

appeal;

b) Every appeal shall be accompanied by an order appealed against, if any, affidavit verifying the facts stated in the appeal and proof of payment of fee.

Every appeal may be presented to First Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority, as the case may be, in person or through registered post or authorized representative.

Fee for filing appeal

Fee for the first appeal shall be rupees two thousand five hundred and for second appeal shall be rupees ten thousand, which shall be non-refundable.

The fee shall be paid in the form of bank demand draft or bankers' cheque of a Scheduled Bank in India payable in the name of Appellate Authority concerned.

Procedure for disposal of appeal

The First Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority, as the case may be, upon filing of appeal, shall issue notice accompanied by copy of appeal, affidavit and documents, if any, to the respondents and fix date of hearing.

On the date fixed for hearing, the First Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority, as the case may be, shall –

Hear all the parties to appeal present before him; and

Peruse or inspect documents, relevant records or copies thereof relating to the matter.

After hearing the parties, perusal or inspection of documents and relevant records or copies thereof relating to the matter, the Appellate Authority concerned shall pass an order in writing and provide the copy of order to the parties to appeal free of cost.

The order passed under sub-clause (c) above shall also be placed on the State Public Procurement Portal.

Additional Conditions of Contract

1. Correction of arithmetical errors

Provided that a Financial Bid is substantially responsive, the Procuring Entity will correct arithmetical errors during evaluation of Financial Bids on the following basis:

- if there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected, unless in the opinion of the Procuring Entity there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected;
- ii) If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of sub totals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and
- iii) If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to (i) and (ii) above.

 If the Bidder that submitted the lowest evaluated bid does not accept the correction of errors, its bid shall be disqualified and its Bid Security shall be forfeited or its Bid Securing Declaration shall be executed.

2. Procuring Entity's Right to Vary Quantities

- (i) At the time of award of contract, the quantity of Goods, works or services originally specified in the Bidding Document may be increased or decreased by a specified percentage, but such increase or decrease shall not exceed twenty percent, of the quantity specified in the Bidding Document. It shall be without any change in the unit price or other terms and conditions of the bid and the conditions of contract.
- (ii) If the Procuring Entity does not procure any subject matter of procurement or procures less than the quantity in the Bidding Document due to change in circumstances, the bidder shall not be entitled for any claim or compensation except otherwise provided in the conditions of contract.
- (iii) In case of procurement of goods or services, additional quantity may be procured by placing a repeat order on the rates and conditions of the original order. However, the additional quantity shall not be more than 25% of the value of goods of the original contract and shall be within one month from the date of expiry of last supply. If the supplier fails to do so, Procuring Entity shall be free to arrange for the balance supply by limited bidding or otherwise and the extra cost incurred shall be recovered from the supplier.

3. Dividing quantities among more than one bidder at the time of award (In case of procurement of goods)

As a general rule all the quantities of the subject matter of procurement shall be procured from the bidder, whose bid is accepted. However, when it is considered that the quantity of the subject matter of procurement to be procured is very large and it may

not be in the capacity of the bidder, whose bid is accepted, to deliver the entire quantity or when it is considered that the subject matter of procurement to be procured is of critical and vital nature, in such cases, the quantity may be divided between the bidder, whose bid is accepted and the second lowest bidder or even more bidders in that order, in a fair, transparent and equitable manner at the rates of the bidder, whose bid is accepted.
