

Reference e-Tender No. RSMM/ CO / GGM (Cont)/Cont-10/2026-27 Dated 23.06.2026 for "Loading of Limestone Gitti of Various sizes into Tippers/ Dumpers from Crusher Hopper (s) and different stacks lying at Company's Sanu Limestone Mines (Mine No.-1 &2), Distt. Jaisalmer, its transportation from Mines to Railway Siding at Sonu railway station, and its unloading & proper stacking etc, watch & ward and mechanized loading of Limestone Gitti into Railway Open Wagons using Front End Loaders etc."

The pre bid meeting was held on dated 30.06.2026 for addressing the issues of prospective bidders. The meeting was attended by GGM (Cont.), Head & Incharge(LS), SM(F&A)LS, SM(F&A)CO, Sr. Manager(Cont.)CO, Sr. Manager(Min./EIC-Transport) & M(Cont)LS . Details of the prospective bidders attended the pre-bid meeting is placed for ready reference..

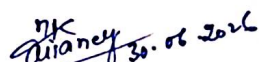
The major issues raised by the prospective bidders are as under:

- i) Formation of co-operative society.
- ii) Acceptance of Bank guarantee towards EMD of previously scrapped tender.

The following issues deliberated in the pre bid meeting were discussed in-house for further decision in the tender procedure.

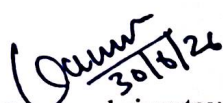
1. Loader loading rate @ Rs. 60/- PMT in place of Rs. 30PMT
(In-house, it was discussed and decided that since the pre-determined rate arrives out considering all incidental factor applicable for execution of work thus no change is required therefore, the same is kept as same as defined in tender document)
2. Formation of co-operative society.
(In-house, it was discussed that the mandatory compliance of execution of work through co-operative society is as per rules and regulation of State Govt. & sufficient time period for formation of co-operative society is provided in the tender document, therefore no changes is required)
3. Acceptance of Bank guarantee towards EMD of previously scrapped tender.
(In-house, it was discussed and decided that since the value of bid security of previously scrapped tender is in excess amount from the existing contract, thus the same can be accepted with proper amendment letter duly issued by bank having validity of BG as per present tender requirement).

All other general queries were addressed in line with the provisions of tender document. Further based on the in house discussions on the points raised during the pre-bid meeting, no changes is required to be carried out in the tender document.

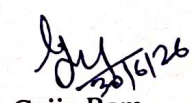

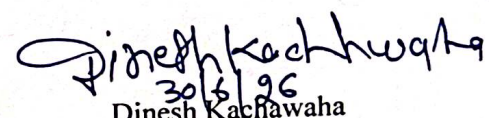
