## CORRIGENDUM NO 1

Sub : Hiring of Heavy Earth Moving Equipments for Removal of Overburden, Raising, Loading and Transportation etc. of Saleable Lignite and allied works at GB-II & Jalelo Pit of Giral Lignite Mines, District Barmer (Rajasthan).

With reference to the above referred tender, kindly note the following amendments in the tender document:

S. No.	Clause no.	Amendment
1	Clause no. 1.1.32 pg no. 7 & wherever applicable	Defination of ““Saleable Lignite” vide clause no. 1.1.32 & wherever applicable may be read as under: “Saleable Lignite means lignite/ carbonaceous material which has calorific value in general in the range of 2700-3300 K Cal/Kg, Insitu.”
2	Clause no. 2.32 pg no. 20	In Existing clause no.2.32 in third line the word “Form A to J” shall be read as “Form A to H”
3	Clause no. 7.2 pg 55	In Existing clause no. 7.2.1 & elsewhere applicable the consumption norms of Diesel shall be read as “0.35 liter per BCM of Rock actually excavated (OB/IB/Lignite) & Loading of lignite form item at S. No. 1 of BOQ.”
4	Clause no. 7.3.1 Pg No. 57	<b>The clause 7.3 relating to Labour Escalation may be read as under:</b> <b>7.3 Labour Escalation:</b> 7.3.1 For labour the escalation/de-escalation shall be considered on 25% of the Part-A (Mining cost). The same shall be on the basis of CPI index and calculated / paid on quarterly basis from the date of issue of DLOA.  For the purpose of this clause ‘Quarter’ would mean the calendar quarter i.e. January-March; April – June; July – September and October to December. Therefore the escalation bills would be payable in January, April, July & October; for the respective previous quarters.  The labour escalation / de-escalation shall be calculated as under:  $L_{EA} = A \times 0.25 \times (CPI_n - CPI_b) / CPI_b,$ where,  $L_{EA}$ is the amount of labour escalation / de-escalation corresponding to the work done during any particular quarter.



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**A** is the gross amount of work done during any particular quarter.

**CPI<sub>b</sub>** is the base Consumer Price Index of All India Industrial Workers as which is 142.6 (for the month of August -2024).

**CPI<sub>n</sub>** is the prevailing price of Consumer Price Index of All India Industrial Workers (CPI) as applicable to the quarter under consideration.

Note : For avoidance of doubt, the CPI declared for the month of April shall be used for escalation calculation of 1<sup>st</sup> quarter; CPI declared for the month of July shall be used for escalation calculation of 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter; CPI declared for the month of Oct shall be used for escalation calculation of 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter and Jan for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter.

7.3.2 An assumption-based illustration for computation of quarterly escalation on account of change in CPI Index is given below:

 Assumed awarded rate of Mining : Rs. 500 PMT of Lignite  
 CPI<sub>b</sub> : 142.6 (as base CPI given in tender)  
 CPI<sub>n</sub> : 144.60 (assumed CPI for April-25  
 Escalation for the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter i.e. April-June-25 payable in July-25

**CPI<sub>b</sub>** = 142.6 (as base CPI given in tender)  
**CPI<sub>n</sub>** + 144.60 (assumed CPI for April-25)

**LEA** =  $A \times 0.25 \times (CPI_n - CPI_b) / CPI_b$   
 = 20000000 X 0.25 X (144.6-142.6)/142.6  
 = 5000000 X 2 / 142.6  
 = 5000000 X 0.014025  
 = Rs. 70126.00
