Bhilwara (Rajasthan) on terms & Conditions annexed herewith. Offered will be considered only in sealed envelopes. Offers sent through mail/fax or any other means will not be considered.

The envelopes containing the offer should be submitted at the earliest but before 05-Feb-2026 upto 6.00 p.m. Part-I of tender will be opened on 06-Feb-2026 at 3.00 p.m. in presence of bidder/s who wish to present at the office of the GM & Head (Bajri Unit), RSMM Ltd., 4, Meera Marg, Udaipur. The tender received after specified due date & time of submission of tender will be treated as late tender and will not be considered at all. Price Bid (Part-II) will be opened later, which will be informed separately to the techno-commercially qualified tenderers only.

Tender must be accompanied with Bid Security of Rs. 3000/- in the form of DD/PO/BC/RTGS/NEFT in favour of Rajasthan State Mines & Minerals Limited, payable at Udaipur. ## Scope of Work and Terms & condition of tender Enquiry

The Government of Rajasthan has allotted three Bajri Plot- River Sand i.e BJ-04 Area- 76.7732 Hect, BJ-05 Area- 67.7059 & BJ-06 Area- 96.9980 Hect near village Akola, Adsipur and Sopura, Tehsil Sawaipur Distt. Bhilwara (Rajasthan) with the objective of ensuring availability of Bajri to the people of Rajasthan on reasonable price.

For the grant of EC of these Bajri Plots, the SEAC-04, Udaipur raised ADS on 06-Oct-2025 for Preparation of Wildlife Conservation Plan for Schedule-I species as per the Wildlife Protection (Amendment) Act, 2022, Wildlife Amendment Act 2023 and guidelines issued from Office of Add. Chief Conservator of Forest and CWLW, Jaipur, Rajasthan vide letter no: WCP/CWLW/2019/6451-6463 dated 24-05-2019.

The authenticated list of Schedule-I Species issued by DCF, Bhilwara, Forest Department vide letter no: F 7()/Survey/DCF/2025/9769 dated 17-12-25 accordingly following species are falling Schedule-I in study area of BJ-04, BJ-05 and BJ-06 as under:

Therefore the Wildlife Conservation Plan of above for 10 (ten) numbers Schedule-I species as per the Wildlife Protection (Amendment) Act, 2022 ; Wildlife Amendment Act 2023 and guidelines issued from Office of Add. Chief Conservator of Forest and CWLW, Jaipur, Rajasthan vide letter no: WCP/CWLW/2019/6451-6463 dated 24-05-2019 is required to prepare in consultation with RSMML.



1. Since this is a limited time specific work, **tenderer have to quote your rate for cumulative work of preparation of all 3 Bajri Plot's Wildlife Conservation Plan (each having 10 species)** in the annexed price bid format (Annexure-III).
2. **The period of the preparation of WCP shall be only 5 (Five) working days from the date of issuance of the work order.**
3. The Wild life Conservation Plan should have to be prepared in consultation with Wildlife / ecology expert and preparation agency should have valid NABET Accredited firm.
4. **Tenderer have to be present in physical on the day of RSMML presentation with SEAC-04 at Udaipur and at SEIAA Office, Jaipur.**
5. The total work is to prepare wild life conservation plan as per authenticated list by DCF, Forest Department, Bhilwara vide letter no: F 7()/Survey/DCF/2025/9769 dated 17-12-25. The plan shall incorporate site-specific conservation measures for all schedule-I species recorded in the study area along with budgetary provisions for their conservation, in consultation with the State Forest Department.
6. The work is to be carried out as per guidelines given by CWLW vide order dated 24-05-2019 and with consultation with DCF Office, Bhilwara and RSMML. After submission of WCP plan to DCF Office Bhilwara, if any objection / scrutiny / additional information required then same is required to complete by tenderer within stipulated time without any additional cost.
7. The Company reserves its sole right to increase or decrease the quantum of work as per provision of RTPP Act on the same rates, terms and conditions.
8. The tenderer may visit our site before submission of their proposal for acquainting information about actual condition of the area & scope of work, if required by them.
9. Tenderer have to work as per guidelines and instruction for wild life conservation plan as per the prevailing Acts/Rules/Guidelines of the State / Central Govt./Departments.
10. The tenderer should work as per norms and guidelines during execution of work in consultation with RSMML.
11. The tenderer have to submit the wild life conservation plan/report to CWLW Jaipur and DCF, Bhilwara in consultation with RSMML and will furnish the receipt of same to RSMML.

12. **BID SECURITY (EMD):-**

The tenderer must pay amount of Rs. 3000/- (three thousand only) as bid security through Demand Draft / Bank pay Order (having validity of three months) in favour of RSMML, Udaipur as per detailed out in TENDER ENQUIRY and drawn on any nationalised/scheduled bank at Udaipur and the same shall be submitted as detailed above in original with technical bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. No interest shall be paid by the company on the bid security so deposited by the tenderer. Bid Security may be also be furnished by way of RTGS/NEFT in RSMML's account as per details below-

**13. SECURITY DEPOSIT**

The successful tenderer shall furnish a Security Deposit equal to 10% of the total contract value through Demand Draft/RTGS/NEFT in favour of RSMML, Udaipur, within **3 working days** of the issuance of such communication of acceptance of tender/Letter of Acceptance/Work Order, for due fulfilment of all or any of the terms & conditions of the contract. No interest is payable on S.D. amount. SD should be valid for a period of 3 months.

In case of non-fulfilment of all or any of the terms & conditions of the contract, SD may be forfeited.

**14. COMPENSATION FOR DELAYED COMPLETION AND RISK & COST:**

In the event of the tenderer fails to complete the work (i.e. WCP not deposited to RSMML) within stipulated period (i.e. 5 days), the Company shall be entitled at its option either:

- a) to recover from the tenderer as agreed pre determined compensation @ 0.5 % (Half percent) per day of value (except GST) of work, subject to a maximum of 5% of the total value (except GST) of work,
- b) either to get the work done from elsewhere, without notice to the tenderer at his risk and cost (full or undelivered part), as the case may be

OR

- c) to cancel the contract.


In case of b & c above, the Company will be empowered to get the work done with alternative source to meet the requirement irrespective of the fact whether these are similar or not.

**16. Payment Terms:**

- a. **80 % payment will be released within 10 days of submitting invoice along-with**
  - i) **Receipt of submission of WCP to the Office of DCF, Bhilwara and CWLW, GoR, Jaipur.**
  - ii) **On recommendation of EC proposal by SEAC-04, Udaipur to SEIAA, Jaipur.**
- b. **15 % payment will be released within 10 days of submitting invoice after the DCF Bhilwara Office forward the WCP to the CF / CCF / CWLW Office.**
- c. **Remaining 5 % payment will be released within 10 days of submitting invoice after the approval of WCP from CWLW Office, Jaipur.**
- d. **Payment will be made through NEFT/RTGS.**
- e. **Payment will be made after deducting statutory taxes wherever applicable.**



**17. VALIDITY OF OFFER- 30 days.**

**18. EVALUATION CRITERIA:**

The Techno-commercial suitability of the offers will be ascertained on the basis of documents submitted along with Part -I of the offer, past experience and/or the information gathered by the RSMML about the tenderer. The decision of the Company shall be final and binding in this regard.

**19. TERMINATION:**

- i) In case of failure to perform the job as required under this tender or observe breach of any of the terms and conditions by the tenderer, the company shall give a notice to rectify such default/breach with 10 days, failure to which may result in termination of the contract and forfeiture of security deposit without any prejudice to the Company's rights to claim damages/ cost/ loss etc caused by such default/ breach. Such termination shall not absolve the tenderer of the liabilities accruing till the date of such termination.
- ii) The contract may also be terminated in the event the tenderer is being adjudged insolvent or going into Liquidation or Winding up of their business, or making arrangement with their creditors.
- iii) Notwithstanding anything contained herein above, the Company in its absolute discretion may at any time terminate the order without assigning any reason thereof by giving fifteen day's notice to the tenderer at their last notified address. In such an event the tenderer shall not be entitled to raise any claim or demand for compensation, loss of profit and/or damages and / or losses or costs by reason of such earlier termination on any ground whatsoever.

**20. FORCE MAJEURE:**

At any time, during the continuance of the contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party (sub-vendors excluded) and/ or obligations under this contract shall be prevented or delayed by reason of any war, Hostility acts of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosion, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, non-performance due to Acts of God or Acts of Government /statutory bodies (herein after referred as "Event") then provided a notice of the happening of any such event is given within seven days from the date of occurrence thereof neither party shall by reason of such event be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damage against the other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance and the deliveries and/or performance of the work under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such event has come to an end or ceased to exist and decision of Company as to whether the deliveries and/or performance of the work have been so resumed or not shall be final and conclusive. Provided further that if the performance in whole or in part is delayed by reasons of any such events for a period exceeding thirty days either party may at its option terminate the contract.

**21. JURISDICTION:**

The contract is subject to the jurisdiction of courts of Udaipur in the state of Rajasthan
