1	e-DNIT: Prequalification Criterion / Eligibility Criteria (Page no. 3) and applicable elsewhere	Inserted In case tenderer is a Company registered under Companies Act, then turnover of the Company shall only be considered. In case the bidder is participating as JV/Consortium, in such case the bidding JV/Consortium shall comprise of not more than three members, i.e. one lead member or lead partner and two other member/partner. In case the bidder is a bidding JV/Consortium, in such cases cumulative turnover of member/ Partner shall be considered for the purpose of qualification. In case of a Joint Venture /Consortium all parties to the Joint Venture shall sign the bid and they shall be jointly and severally liable or the Joint Venture/Consortium shall nominate a representative who shall have the authority to conduct all business for and on behalf of any or all the parties of the Joint Venture /Consortium during the bidding process. In the event the bid of Joint Venture is accepted, they shall form a registered Joint Venture company. Tenderer(s) (including any partner/member of JV/Consortium), who have been banned/debarred by the Company or any State/Central Government Organization/Department shall not be eligible to participate in this tender/during the currency of

2	Clause 4.2: Period of Agreement and commencement of work (Page no. 26) and applicable elsewhere	Existing Provision The successful bidder has two options under supply agreement i.e. Option-1 (supply to existing cement plant): Obtain all statutory clearance and complete preparatory work at site within 18 months' time from the date of award of the work and commence the production within 18 months from date of issuance of DLOA and supply to already existing cement plant under captive use. Option-2 (supply in proposed new plant): If the prospective bidder desires to construct a new plant, party has to inform RSMML in writing within 90 days from the date of signing of agreement about his intention of doing so. The work of Construction and Commissioning of the plant intended for captive consumption shall be completed within 36 months from the date of issuance of DLOA to the successful bidder. Meanwhile, successful bidder also obtains all statutory clearance and complete preparatory work at site simultaneously. On the request of bidder, the allowable time period for Construction and Commissioning of the plant along with obtaining all statutory clearance may be extended beyond 36 months by RSMML if justified, based on the request of the successful bidder supported by documentary evidence demonstrating reasons for the delay. Thereafter, RSMML will be free to take action for termination of the DLOA along with forfeiture of EMD/SD amount.



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	<u>Shall be Read As</u> The successful bidder has either one of the two options under supply agreement i.e. Option-1 or Option-2. The prospective bidder has to inform RSMML in writing within 90 days from the date of signing of the agreement about his intention to opt for either Option-1 or Option-2. Option-1 (supply to existing cement plant): Obtain all statutory clearance and complete preparatory work at site within 18 months' time from the date of award of the work and commence the production within 18 months from date of issuance of DLOA and supply to already existing cement plant under captive use. Option-2 (supply in proposed new plant): The work of Construction and Commissioning of the plant intended for captive consumption shall be completed within 36 months from the date of issuance of DLOA to the successful bidder. Meanwhile, successful bidder also obtains all statutory clearance and complete preparatory work at site simultaneously. On the request of bidder, the allowable time period for Construction and Commissioning of the plant along with obtaining all statutory clearance may be extended beyond 36 months by RSMML if justified, based on the request of the successful bidder supported by documentary evidence demonstrating reasons for the delay. Thereafter, RSMML will be free to take action for termination of the DLOA along with forfeiture of EMD/SD amount.
