SECTION - I

1.0 Instructions for preparation & submission of e-Tender and Conditions of e-Tender:

- ii) The **Tender document fee** shall be in the form of Demand Draft/Bankers Cheque/Bank Pay Order/RTGS/NEFT drawn **in favour of “Rajasthan State Mines & Minerals Limited” payable at Jaipur** and shall be submitted to the office of the GGM (MM), 4-Meera Marg, Udaipur up to schedule date and time, as above.

2.0 SUBMISSION & OPENING OF TENDERS:

The online submission of bids on the e-procurement portal i.e. <http://eproc.rajasthan.gov.in> within the specified date and time will be the sole responsibility of the Tenderers. In case the date of opening of bids happens to be a holiday, then the bids shall be opened on the next working day.

Tenderers are requested to ensure submitting their tender online on e-procurement portal only and furnishing Demand Draft / Bankers Cheque/Bank Pay Orders/RTGS/NEFT details towards tender document fee/Bid Security/ Processing Fees offline to the office of GGM (Lignite) within the specified time & date of submission. Tenders in physical form (offline) will not be acceptable in any case.

Tenderers may note that they will not be able to submit their tenders online after the specified/ scheduled date & time of submission of bid document. Tenderers should also to ensure furnishing Demand Draft / Bankers Cheque/ Bank Pay Orders /RTGS/NEFT details towards tender document fee/Bid Security/ Processing Fees to the office of GGM (Lignite) within the specified time & date of submission. Failing which, their online bids will not be opened.

3.0 VALIDITY:

The tenderer shall keep the offer open for acceptance by RSMML for a minimum period of 4 months from the date of opening of tender (Part-I), within which period the tenderer shall have no right to withdraw, cancel, amend or modify his offer. In case of withdrawal/cancellation/ amendment/ modification in the offered tender, the Bid Security deposited by the tenderer shall stand forfeited. The validity period may be extended further, if required, by mutual consent from time to time.

In case, tenderer, after issuance of communication of acceptance of offer (LOA/PO) by RSMML, fails to execute the contract as per the conditions therein, such an event will be considered as the tenderer's calculated willful breach of the contract. The cost & consequence in such cases shall be on the sole account of the tenderer. Moreover, RSMML have full right to claim damages thereof in addition to the forfeiture of Bid Security.

4.0 BID SECURITY, TENDER DOCUMENT FEES & PROCESSING FEES:

- a) The tenderer shall deposit (interest free) a sum of **Rs. 20,800/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Eight Hundered Only)** as Bid Security in the form of Demand Draft/Bankers Cheque/Bank Pay Orders/RTGS/NEFT payable to RSMML, Jaipur.
- b) Further, tenderers shall deposit a sum Rs. 1,180/- towards tender document fees and Rs. 500/- towards processing fees by Demand Draft/Bankers Cheque/Bank Pay Orders/RTGS/NEFT only to the office of GGM (Lignite) within the specified date & time. - c) **The Bid Security shall be forfeited in case of :**
 - i) If tenderer unsolicited revises and/or modifies and/or withdraw &/or cancel/amend the offer at its own after submission of tender during the validity period.
 - ii) If it is established that tenderer has submitted any wrong information/forged document along with the tender or thereafter.
 - iii) If the tenderer declines to accept contract/order placed by the Company subsequent to acceptance of his offer.
 - iv) If the tenderer does not submit the security deposit cum performance guarantee.
 - v) If the tenderer breaches any provision of code of integrity prescribed for bidder as detailed at Annexure -A.
- d) The Bid Security furnished by the unsuccessful tenderers will be refunded after finalization of tender &/or validity of the offer has expired. Bid Security of successful tenderer will be refunded after receipt of Security Deposit cum performance guarantee.

- (e) The Bid Security of a tenderer lying with the company in respect of other tenders awaiting approval or rejected or on account of contract completed will not be adjusted towards bid security against this tender, however, the bid security originally deposited may be taken into consideration in case tender is re-invited. However, tender document fees and processing fees have to be furnished afresh in case of re-tender.

5.0 SECURITY DEPOSIT CUM PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE:

- i) As security for the due, proper and faithful fulfillment of the obligations under the contract, the tenderer will furnish to RSMML Security Deposit cum Performance Guarantee equal to 10% of total value of contract (For Supply, Installation, Commissioning of one no. 11/√3 KV Neutral Grounding Resistor (NGR) in the form of Demand Draft/RTGS/NEFT or in the form of Bank Guarantee in RSMML Performa by public Sector Banks and Private Sector banks as per schedule II of the Reserve Bank of India Act, 1954 as per list enclosed at annexure-XII having its Branch at Jaipur, within 21 days from the date of PO on the stamp paper of appropriate value. An undertaking as per annexure-XIII will also be submitted along with the B.G.

Security Deposit Cum Performance Guarantee” may also be furnished by the way of FDR in addition to existing methods mentioned in tender. FDR should be furnished as per provisions of RTPP Rule 75(3)(e), as below-

“Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) of a scheduled bank. It shall be in the name of procuring entity on account of bidder and discharged by the bidder in advance. The procuring entity shall ensure before accepting the Fixed Deposit Receipt that the bidder furnishes an undertaking from the bank to make payment/premature payment of the Fixed Deposit Receipt on demand to the procuring entity without requirement of consent of the bidder concerned. In the event of forfeiture of the performance security, the Fixed Deposit shall be forfeited along with interest earned on such Fixed Deposit”.

- ii) The BG shall liable to be invoked/ amount of SD is liable to be forfeited wholly or partly at the sole discretion of the Company, should the supplier either fails to execute the work within the stipulated period or fails to fulfill the agreed obligations or fails to settle in full it's dues to the Company.
- iii) The Company is empowered to recover from the S.D. any sum due and /or any other sum that may be fixed by the Company as being the amount or loss or losses or damages suffered by it due to un-satisfactory performance or non fulfillment of any of the conditions of the tender/ contract.
- iv) The Bank Guarantee/ S.D. shall remain in force and binding, notwithstanding, if any variation, alternation, modifications are made to the contract or any extension of the contract period is granted by RSMML.
- v) RSMML shall not pay any interest on the Security Deposit. The security Deposit shall be released on application by the Supplier after the expiry of guarantees and after discharge of all the supplier's obligations under the contract.
- vi) The said Security shall not in any way be construed as a limitation of the supplier's responsibility or liability pertaining to its obligations and guarantees under the contract and shall be without prejudice to any other remedies available to RSMML in terms of the contract and/ or as per the laws of the land.

6.0 RELAXATION IN TENDER DOCUMENT FEES, BID SECURITY & SECURITY DEPOSIT CUM PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE TO MSME, GOR:

- (A) Tenderers offering in capacity of micro, small and medium enterprises of the State of Rajasthan, having acknowledgement of Entrepreneurs Memorandum-II/Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum as mentioned in Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006, issued by the competent authority facilitated, on furnishing of a self-attested copy of acknowledgement of Entrepreneurs Memorandum-II/Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum, following relaxations will be provided, if sought by the bidder along with supporting documents-
 - i) Tender document fees will be taken @50% of the prescribed total value of Tender document fees.
 - ii) Bid Security will be taken @25% of the total value of Bid Security. In case of offering the quantity lesser than the tendered quantity, then they can submit proportionate amount of bid security in proportion to the quantity being offered with respect to the bid security amount for tender quantity.

- iii) Security Deposit will be taken @ 0.5% of the total value of order.
- (B) In case of participation by Undertakings, Corporations, Autonomous Bodies which are controlled and managed by Govt., Govt. 7.0 SCOPE OF WORK, SPECIFICATIONS & QUANTITY:

- i) The scope of the work shall consist of execution of “Supply, Installation, Commissioning & Testing of one no. 11/ $\sqrt{3}$ KV Neutral Grounding Resistor (NGR) at Kasnau-Matasukh Mines, Nagaur”, as per the details mentioned in the Annexure ‘VI’ and instructions issued by the Engineer In charge /authorized representative from time to time on the basis of work order issued indicating the location and description of job to be executed. The good quality of workmanship shall be ensured at all the times. The working site will be at 33/11KV GSS at Kasnau-Matasukh Mines, Nagaur of SBU&PC-Lignite.
- ii) For installation work, supplier shall have valid A-class Electrical Contractor License issued by the Electrical Inspector, Govt. of Rajasthan or work of installation & commissioning shall be carried out through the contractor having A-class Electrical Contractor License issued by the Electrical Inspector, Govt. of Rajasthan. Before installation, supplier shall submit A-class contractor License as above.
- iii) The contractor shall comply with the Indian Electricity Act- 1956, CEA (Measures Relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulations -2010 & Rules and standard practice framed there under and Regulations laid down by the Dy. Director Mines Safety (Electrical), Department of Mines Safety, Govt. of India. All relevant labour laws and Safety Regulations are required to be followed by the contractor during the tenure of the contract.
- iv) The contractor shall be required to work in and around an open cast Lignite mines, GSS. He is required to adhere with all safety regulations and safety gadgets for employees working, to complete the work. The contractor shall follow all safe methods of working so that no damage/loss is caused to the workers. RSMML shall not be responsible in any way for the injury caused to the contractor’s employees /labour’s while working.
- v) All technical terms and conditions, specifications, to carry out the work mentioned in AVVNL, Central Labour Rate Contract/PWD BSR or reference, if any, shall be applicable.
- vi) Any item not covered in the Annexure ‘VI’ shall be executed on mutually agreed rates, terms & conditions, if required so due to the site requirements.
- vii) Three sets of drawings and one set of equipment’s manual for whole works would be provided to EIC.

8.0 INSTALLATION & COMMISSIONING OF $11/\sqrt{3}$ KV Neutral Grounding Resistor (NGR) :

The tenderer will be responsible for Installation, Commissioning & Testing work of the equipment at site. The tenderer shall depute qualified and competent technical & other staff to Supervise, Install, Commission and Testing of the equipment free of cost for suitable man days and for test day running as well as training in operation and maintenance of the equipment at site.

9.0 PRE-QUALIFICATION CRETERIA:

- i. The Tenderer should have minimum turnover of Rs. 05.00 Lac in any one of the last three preceding financial years i.e. 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25 in the tenderer name.

The Techno-commercial suitability of the offers will be ascertained on the basis of pre-qualification criteria, documents submitted along with Part –I of the offer and/or the information gathered by the RSMML about the tenderer. The price offer of only techno-commercially qualified Tenderer(s) will be opened on a later date, which will be informed to qualified Tenderer(s) only . The decision of the Company shall be final and binding in this regard.

11.0 RSMML's RIGHT:

The Company reserves the following rights at its sole discretion without assigning any reason thereof:

- a) to reject any or all the tenders received.
- b) to accept a tender either for the total scope of work or part thereof & not to accept the lowest tenderer.
- c) To accept/reject any tender on technical grounds based on RSMML requirement.
- d) to cancel the tender, postpone it for another date, change the venue of the receipt of the tender.
- e) to increase/decrease the quantity as per work requirement.
- f) to purchase / not to purchase additional load cells.

The decision of the Company in above regards shall be final and binding on the tenderer. As a result of such change the Company will not entertain any claim whatsoever.

12.0 RATES :

- i)** The price should be quoted on-line in Indian Currency strictly in Price Bid (BOQ) Cover – C on f.o.r. destination basis.
- ii)** **Tenderer (s) are requested to offer prices strictly in the BOQ uploaded on the site. They should first download the BOQ from the site on their system and after filling it, the same BOQ should be uploaded on the e-procurement portal. Further, tenderers are advised to recheck the filled prices of each item to its correctness before uploading the BoQ on portal. RSMML will not entertain any claim on this account at any point of time.**
- iii)** The quoted price shall be on F.O.R. destination basis inclusive of basic price, Taxes, Duties, Levies, Packing, Forwarding, Transportation, Insurance, any other Delivery Charges etc. up to destination. The quoted price will remain firm and fixed till complete execution of the contract.
- iv)** Timely deposition of GST and filing of requisite tax returns of relevant tax period would be the sole responsibility of the supplier. The supplier will also ensure that necessary credit on this account is available to RSMML in the next month. - v)** In case of reversal of Input Tax Credit (ITC), imposition of penalty on account of payment of GST and default in filing of returns towards the payment for the work, supplier is liable to pay all such dues to the company, failing which RSMML is free to deduct /recover/ retain such amount from the bills of supplier or any other amount due to him/ or from Security Deposit, as the case may be.

1. Filing an appeal

If any Bidder or prospective bidder is aggrieved that any decision, action or omission of the Procuring Entity is in contravention to the provisions of the Act or the Rules or the Guidelines issued thereunder, he may file an appeal to First Appellate Authority, as specified in the Bidding Document within a period of ten days from the date of such decision or action, omission, as the case may be clearly giving the specific ground or grounds on which he feels aggrieved:

Provided that after the declaration of a Bidder as successful the appeal may be filed only by a Bidder who has participated in the procurement proceedings:

Provided further that in case a Procuring Entity evaluates the technical bids before the opening of the financial Bids, an appeal related to the matter of Financial Bids may be filed only by a Bidder whose Technical Bid is found to be acceptable.

- 2.** The officer to whom an appeal is filed under para (1) shall deal with the appeal as expeditiously as possible and shall endeavour to dispose it of within thirty days from the date of the appeal.
- 3.** If the officer designated under para (1) fails to dispose of the appeal filed within the period specified in para (2) or if the Bidder or prospective bidder or the Procuring Entity is aggrieved by the order passed by the First Appellate Authority, the bidder or prospective bidder or the Procuring Entity, as the case may be, may file a second appeal to Second Appellate Authority specified in the Bidding Document in this behalf within fifteen days from the expiry of the period specified in para (2) or of the date of receipt of the order passed by the First Appellate Authority, as the case may be .

4. Appeal not to lie in certain cases

No appeal shall lie against any decision of the Procuring Entity relating to the following matters, namely:-

- a. Determination of need of procurement;
- b. Provisions limiting participation of Bidders in the Bid process;
- c. The decision of whether or not to enter into negotiations ;
- d. Cancellation of a procurement process;

5. Form of Appeal

7. Procedure for disposal of appeal

Annexure D : Additional Conditions of Contract

1. Correction of arithmetical errors

Provided that a Financial Bid is substantially responsive, the Procuring Entity will correct arithmetical errors during evaluation of Financial Bids on the following basis:

- (i) if there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected, unless in the opinion of the Procuring Entity there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected;
- (ii) If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of sub totals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and
- (iii) If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to (i) and (ii) above.

If the Bidder that submitted the lowest evaluated bid does not accept the correction of errors, its bid shall be disqualified and its Bid Security shall be forfeited or its Bid Securing Declaration shall be executed.

2. Procuring Entity's Right to Vary Quantities
