SECTION- I: INSTRUCTION FOR PREPARATION & SUBMISSION OF TENDER:

- 1.1** One copy of tender documents is sent herewith, which should be sealed & signed as a token of acceptance of its terms and conditions and returned intact, (no page should be detached).
- 1.2** Tender must be submitted in two parts i.e. Techno - Commercial (Part – I) and Price Bid (Part – II). The tender should be packed in four sealed envelopes as elaborated below. Each Envelop should be super scribed tender no. as mentioned above.

- i) **Sealed Envelop No. 1:-** This envelop should contain Bid Security as per tender document. The envelop should be super scribed Bid Security towards tender No. (as mentioned above).
- ii) **Sealed Envelop No. 2 :** This envelop should contain Part –I: Techno-Commercial BID alongwith all supporting documents (except the Bid Security & Price Bid) as asked in the tender document. This sealed envelope should be super scribed Part –I of tender No (as mentioned above).

The tenderer / bidder should give a declaration with Part – 1 of the offer that they have not been banned/suspended or de-listed by RSMML. If this declaration is not given, the bid will be treated as non responsive.

- iii) **Sealed Envelop No. 3** i.e. Part-II (PRICE BID) : This envelop should contain only Price Part as per provisions mentioned in the tender. The sealed envelope should be super scribed PART – II (Price Part) of Tender No. (as mentioned above). No condition should be stipulated in this part, if any, shall be ignored.
- iv) **Sealed Envelop No. 4:** The above three sealed envelopes should be packed in another sufficiently large envelop to enable it to be opened without tearing the inner sealed envelopes. The outer cover should bear address of the authority who has invited tender and super-scribed there on Tender No (as mentioned above) and the details of above mentioned three envelops. In case above mentioned pattern for submitting tender document is not followed by the tenderer, their offer may liable to be ignored.

1.3 DELIVERY OF TENDER:

- i) The submission and delivery of tenders within the specified date and time will be the sole responsibility of the Tenderer. In case the last date of submission/ opening of tender happen to be a holiday, then tenders shall be submitted/ opened on the next working day upto/ at prescribed time.
- ii) **Late Tender:** The tender received after specified due date & time of submission of tender will be treated as late tender and will not be considered at all.
- iii) RSMML will not be responsible for delay in delivery of the tenders through post/speed post/courier/personal or any other means.

1.4 Tenderer should quote as far as possible in the form & pattern, as envisaged herein. It will help in making proper comparison & avoid any errors/ omissions.

1.5 Tenders other than on the prescribed lines, form and pattern described herein are liable to be ignored as it could make comparison erroneous.

1.6 Printed conditions on the back of letters originating from Tenderer will be ignored.

Provisions of Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Act,2012 and Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Rule,2013 & subsequent amendments time to time, will also be applicable.

1.7 EXCEPTIONS & DEVIATIONS: Tenderers are advised to submit their offer based on terms & conditions and specifications contained in the tender document and not to stipulate any deviations. Offer containing stipulations of deviations to the terms & conditions are liable to be ignored. In case it is absolutely unavoidable to deviate from tender conditions & if the tenderer desires to propose any addition/deviation /alterations to any of the terms and conditions contained in the tender document, the same must be expressed clearly in annexure – **III** and furnished along-with part-I of the offer, without making any correction on the body of the tender documents. In the absence of it, it will be deemed as unqualified acceptance by the Tenderer to all terms and conditions contained herein. Tenderers should mention the deviations at their risk of rejection only. Deviations mentioned anywhere else in the offer shall be ignored without any consequences to the company. Quotation qualified by such vague and indefinite expressions as "SUBJECT TO IMMEDIATE ACCEPTANCE" or "SUBJECT TO PRIOR SALE" are liable to be ignored.

Tenders containing corrections and alterations are liable to be rejected unless all such corrections and alterations are signed & stamped by the tenderer.

1.8 BEFORE SUBMITTING TENDER:

Tenderer shall be deemed to have satisfied himself of all conditions liable to be encountered during the execution of the contract or rates quoted in the offer are adequate and all inclusive in respect to all factors circumstances and conditions likely to be incidental to the execution of the contract, as per the scope and conditions given herein.

1.9 AUTHORITY TO SIGN TENDER:

The tender should be signed by the person who is legally authorised to enter into commitments on behalf of the Tenderer.

1.10 OPENING OF TENDERS:

Tenders will be opened on the fixed date and time in the presence of Tenderer or their authorised representative who may wish to be present on the opening of the tender at the place, time and date as specified in the schedule. In case the date of opening of tenders happens to be a holiday, the tenders shall be opened on the next full working day at prescribed time.

1.11 VALIDITY:

The tenderer shall keep the offer open for acceptance by RSMML for a minimum period of Four months from the date of opening of tender within which period the tenderer shall have no right to withdrawn, amend, cancel or modify his offer. In case of withdrawal/amendment/ modification/ cancellation the Bid Security deposited by the tenderer, as per clause No.1.12 hereof shall stand forfeited. The validity period may be extended for further period, if required, by mutual consent from time to time.

In case, tenderer, after issuance of communication of acceptance of offer by RSMML, fails to execute the contract as per the conditions of the contract, such an event will be considered as the tenderer's calculated willful breach of the contract, the cost & consequence of which shall be on the sole account of the tenderer. Moreover, RSMML have full right to claim damages thereof in addition to the forfeiture of Bid Security.

1.12 BID SECURITY:

1. The tenderer shall deposit (interest free) a sum of **Rs 2740/- (Rupees Two Thousand Seven Hundred & Forty only)** as Bid Security alongwith the tender by Demand Draft/PO/RTGS/NEFT. It should be in favour of RSMML payable at Udaipur. Offers not accompanied with the requisite will not be considered. Bid Security in any manner other than DD/PO/BC/RTGS/NEFT will not be accepted.
- b) While opening of the tender, the envelope containing BID SECURITY will be opened first and in case the same is found as per tender requirement, then only the sealed envelope containing part-I & part- II of offer will be opened. The offer of the tenderer(s) who has not furnished Bid Security of requisite amount and in prescribed manner will not be considered.
- c) **The BID SECURITY shall be forfeited in case of:**
 - i) If tenderer unsolicited revises and/or modifies and/or withdraw and/or amend and/or cancel their tender at its own after submission of tender.
 - ii) If it is established that tenderer have submitted any wrong information/forged document alongwith the tender or thereafter/ found indulge in unfair trade practices.
 - iii) If the tenderer declines to accept contract/order placed by the Company subsequent to acceptance of his offer.
 - iv) If the tenderer does not submit the security deposit cum performance guarantee.
 - v) If the tenderer breaches any provision of code of integrity prescribed for bidder as detailed at Annexure –A.
- (d)The Bid Security furnished by the unsuccessful tenderers will be refunded after finalization of tender / validity of the offer has expired. Bid Security of successful tenderer will be refunded after receipt of Security Deposit cum performance guarantee.
- (e) The Bid Security of a tenderer lying with the company in respect of other tenders awaiting approval or rejected or on account of contract completed will not be adjusted towards earnest money deposit against this tender, however, the earnest money originally deposited may be taken into consideration in case tender is re-invited.
- (f) Bid Security may also be furnished by the way of RTGS/NEFT in the account of RSMML in addition to other modes already prescribed in the relevant clauses of the tender document.**

1.13 SECURITY DEPOSIT CUM PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE:

- i) Successful bidder(s) is to furnish Security Deposit cum Performance Guarantee (Performance Security) as below-

The rate of security deposit (performance security) as per the prevailing terms and condition of the Company is @ 5% of total estimated order value. However, the reduced performance security @ 2.5% of the total order value will be taken initially in compliance of the notification dated 18.12.2020 issued by finance department, Govt. of Rajasthan pertaining to amendment in RTPP Rule no. 75(2) applicable up to 31.03.2023. In case, The Govt. of Rajasthan either revises the rates of security deposit (performance security) later at any date or does not extend the existing date of providing the benefits of reduced security deposit (i.e. 31.03.2023), the successful bidder would be bound to deposit the deferential security deposit amount toward performance security either through any options as specified below, within a period of 30 days of the demand raised by the Company. In case of non-payment of deferential amount in the stipulated time period (or as extended by the company), the company may recover the same from due payments to bidder and/or take penal action as per provision of tender/other guidelines.

- ii) Security Deposit cum Performance Guarantee will be submitted by the bidder in the form of Demand Draft or in the form of Bank Guarantee in RSMML Performa from any Public Sector /ICICI/HDFC/AXIS Bank (except state Bank of India) having its Branch at Udaipur, within 21 days from the date of LOA/RC on the stamp paper of appropriate value. The Bank Guarantee should be valid for a period of 6 months in excess of the warrantee period.
- iii) The BG shall liable to be invoked/ amount of SD is liable to be forfeited wholly or partly at the sole discretion of the Company, should the tenderer either fails to execute the work within the stipulated period or fails to fulfill the agreed obligations or fails to settle in full, it's dues to the Company.
- iv) The Company is empowered to recover any sum due and /or any other sum that may be fixed by the Company as being the amount or loss or losses or damages suffered by it due to unsatisfactorily performance or non fulfillment of any of the conditions of the tender/contract from the S.D.
- v) The Bank Guarantee/ S.D. shall remain in force and binding, notwithstanding, if any variation, alternation, modifications are made to the contract or any extension of the contract period are granted by RSMML.
- vi) RSMML shall not pay any interest on the Security Deposit. The security Deposit shall be released on application by the contractor after the expiry of guarantee and after discharge of all the tenderer's obligations under the contract.
- vii) The said Security shall not in any way be construed as a limitation of the tenderer's responsibility or liability pertaining to its obligations and guarantee under the contract and shall be without prejudice to any other remedies available to RSMML in terms of the contract and or as per the laws of the land.
- viii) Incase SD is being furnished in the form of Bank Guarantee, the BG should be furnished on the non-judicial stamp paper of the value equal to 0.1% (Zero Point One Percent) of security deposit amount or of Rs. 200/-, whichever is higher or as amended/revised.
- ix) Bank Guarantee/S.D. should be send to the office of GGM (MM), CO.

1.14 COMPENSATION FOR DELAYED COMPLETION:

In the event of the supplier fail to deliver the stores as per agreed specifications in full/part as per delivery schedule, the Company shall be entitled at its option either:

- a) to recover from the supplier as agreed compensation @ $\frac{1}{2}$ % of the value of the undelivered stores, for each week or part thereof subject to a maximum of **5%** of value of undelivered store.
 - b) to purchase from elsewhere , without notice to supplier at his risk and cost for full or undelivered part, as the case may be.
- OR
- c) to cancel the contract

In case of (b& c) Company will be empowered to purchase the stores which are readily available to meet his requirements, irrespective of the fact whether these are similar or not.

1.15 NO COMPENSATION FOR ALTERATION OF DELIVERY SCHEDULE OR SUSPENSION OF SUPPLIES:

If at any time before the commencement of the supply if the Company, for any reason, whatsoever do not require the whole supply or part thereof as specified in the LOA/RC, shall give notice in writing of the same to the supplier and the supplier shall not be entitled for any compensation and/or damage of any kind whatsoever on account for loss or profit etc. nor the contractor be entitled to any claim for compensation for re-scheduling of delivery period.

1.16 TERMINATION:

- a) In case of failure to perform the job as required under this contract or observe breach of any of the terms and conditions by the tenderer, the company shall give a notice to rectify such default/breach within 10 days. Failure to rectify such default/ breach may result in termination of the Purchase Order and forfeiture of security deposit without any prejudice to the Company's rights to claim damages/ cost/ loss etc caused by such default/ breach. Such termination shall not absolve the tenderer of the liabilities accruing till the date of such termination.
- b) The contract may also be terminated in the event the tenderer is being adjudged insolvent or going into Liquidation or Winding up of their business, or making arrangement with their creditors.
- c) Not withstanding anything contained herein above, the Company in its absolute discretion may at any time terminate the order without assigning any reason thereof by giving fifteen day's notice to the tenderer at their last notified address. In such an event the tenderer shall not be entitled to raise any claim or demand for compensation, loss of profit and/or damages and / or losses or costs by reason of such earlier termination on any ground whatsoever.

1.17 FORCE MAJEURE:

If at any time, during the continuance of the contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party (sub-vendors excluded) and/or obligations under this contract shall be prevented or delayed by reason of any war, Hostility acts of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods,

explosion, epidemics, quarantine restrictions ,non-performance due to Acts of God or Acts of Government (hereinafter referred to as “Event”) then provided a notice of the happening of any such event is given within **seven days** from the date of occurrence thereof neither party shall by reason of such event be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damage against the other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance and the deliveries and/or performance of the work under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such event has come to an end or ceased to exist and decision of Company as to whether the deliveries and/or performance of the work have been so resumed or not shall be final and conclusive. Provided further that if the performance in whole or in part is delayed by reasons of any such events for a period exceeding thirty days either party may at its option terminate the contract.

1.18 JURISDICTION: The contract is subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts of Udaipur in the state of Rajasthan only.

SECTION-II : SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT (SCC)

RSMML intent to enter into rate contract for supply of electrodes for various welding jobs at our SBU-PC(RP), Jhamarkotra Mines and SBU-PC(LS) Sanu Mines, Jaisalmer based on desirable characteristics as per Annexure-VI.

Tenderers are requested to offer the details of most suited electrode manufactured/marketed by them for each type of welding application in the Annexure - VI alongwith detailed technical specification, technical leaflet etc of each type of electrode offered by tenderer. RSMML may ask the bidders to submit 5 pieces of each type of offered Electrodes in 4 mm. size for technical evaluation.

On the basis of the technical details of the electrode, the evaluation for selection will be made and offered prices only for selected electrodes will be taken for evaluation.

The approximate quantity of each type of electrode is mentioned in Annexure - VI. The quantity mentioned herein above is tentative & indicative only. However, the supply of each type of electrodes will be taken as per actual requirement of RSMML on as and when required basis. The quantity may vary from the above indicative quantity and will be in phased manner during the currency of the contract. The supply is required at SBU-PC (RP), Jhamarkotra & SBU-PC (LS), Jaisalmer on f.o.r. destination basis.

2.1 PERIOD OF CONTRACT:

The period of contract will be one year from the date of issue of LOA/RC. RSMML may extend the RC period for 3 months on same rates, terms & conditions at its sole discretion.

2.2 SCOPE OF SUPPLY:

- a) The Scope of Supply shall be the delivery of stores by the supplier as per tender in accordance with the agreed specification Term and conditions of the Tender.
- b) The supplier shall be deemed to have carefully examined and have knowledge of the general and other conditions, schedules, drawings and all other documents forming part of the contract, and also to have satisfied himself as to the nature and character of the stores to be delivered under the contract.
- c) The supplier shall be entirely responsible for the performance of the contract in all respects according to the intent and meaning of the drawings, specification data and assignment or subcontracting. Any approval which the Company may have given in respect of the stores, materials or other particulars of the workmanship involved in the contract (whether with or without test carried out by the supplier or Company) shall not bind the Company and notwithstanding any approval or acceptance given by the company it shall be lawful for the Company to reject the material on arrival at site if it is found after inspection that the stores supplied by the supplier are not in conformity with the contract in all respects.

2.3 RATES:

- a) The rates should be quoted in Annexure - "VIII" appended hereto. The quoted rate shall remain firm & fixed till the complete execution of the contract and on f.o.r. destination basis inclusive of Packing & Forwarding, freight, Insurance and any other delivery charges up to destination. No escalation on whatsoever ground will be admissible. The price quoted should be both in figures and words. In case of any discrepancy between the figures and words, the lower of the two shall be taken as the quoted price.
- b) Entries should be neat and legible without any correction. Corrections, if any, must be signed in full and dated.
- c) The charges towards duties, taxes, levies or any other charges as applicable for the supply of ordered store must be stated specifically. Applicable GST on Transportation, Insurance & any other charges, if applicable should also be considered & offered while filling GST charges (IGST/CGST/SGST) in Annexure-VIII. In the absence of any such stipulation it will be presumed that the price include all such charges and no claim whatsoever for the same will be entertained.
- d) The prices quoted must be in figures & words both. In case, if there is any difference, the lower of them will be considered.

2.4 DETERMINATION OF LOWEST BIDDER:

- a. The lowest tenderer shall be determined separately for each type on the basis of total landed cost of the offered Electrodes at our Jhamarkotra/ Jaisalmer Mines basis inclusive of transportation, Insurance & any other delivery charges up to destination for the supply of stores except IGST /CGST/SGST. The effect of any direct/ indirect tax/duties/levies imposed by the Govt. of Rajasthan/ Central Govt. On supply of tendered store will be given while calculating the landed cost as per GST guidelines.
- b. In case RSMML opt for entering into RC with more than one tenderer, then initially L2 tenderer will be extended opportunity to match L1 rate after giving effects, as above, on refusal by L2 tenderer, then to L3 tenderer & so on.
- c. In the event the company does not find the lowest quoted rate, acceptable to it, then the tender will be scrapped and may be re-tender, or company may take any other suitable action as deemed fit looking to the exigency of the work.
- d. **NEGOTIATIONS:**
 - i) Negotiations may be conducted with the lowest tenderer only. In case of non-satisfactory achievement of rates from lowest tenderer, RSMML may choose to make a written counter offer to the lowest tenderer and if this is not accepted, RSMML may decide to reject and re-invite fresh tenders or to make the same counter-offer first to the second lowest tenderer, then to the third lowest tenderer and so on in the order of initial bidding, and work order be awarded to the tenderer who accepts the counter offer.
 - ii) In the case, when the quotations given by the tenderer during negotiations is higher than the original quotation of the tenderer then the tenderer will be bound by the lower rate originally quoted by the tenderer.

- iii) In case of negotiations, representative of the tenderer attending negotiations must possess written authority from the tenderer to the effect that he is competent to modify/amend the submitted tender deviations and rates offered by them.

2.5 PRICE VARIATION:

The quoted price should remain firm and fixed till the complete execution of the contract. Only variation on account of changes in Taxes & Duties by the Government will be considered on production of documentary proof. No escalation/variation on any other grounds whatsoever shall be considered or be admissible.

- a) **Escalation / de-escalation on Government Taxes & Duties:** The tenderer will indicate in his offer the applicable Taxes & duties at the time of submission of tender. In the event of any increase/decrease in the Taxes & duties by the Government, the difference of the same shall be passed on to the tenderer/RSMML as the case may be. The subsequent increase shall be payable only on the production of authentic documentary proof by the tenderer.
- b) Save and except as aforesaid, the tenderer shall not be entitled to raise any claim and/or demand and/or any dispute on account of escalation or raise or increase in the prices.
- c) Timely deposition of GST and filing of requisite tax returns of relevant tax period would be the sole responsibility of the supplier. The supplier will also ensure that necessary credit on this account is available to RSMML in the next month. In case of any discrepancy, where credit is not available to RSMML, then company is free to deduct/recover/retain such amount from the bills of supplier or any other amount due to him/ or from Security Deposit, as the case may be.
- d) In case of reversal of Input Tax Credit (ITC), imposition of penalty on account of payment of GST and default in filing of returns towards the payment for the work, supplier is liable to pay all such dues to the company, failing which RSMML is free to deduct /recover/ retain such amount from the bills of supplier or any other amount due to him/ or from Security Deposit, as the case may be.
- e) The bidder shall submit an undertaking with monthly bills bearing GSTIN and HSN/SAC Code that " total GST has been deposited and returns have been filed for relevant tax period."
- f) In addition, a general undertaking shall also be furnished by the bidder at the time of submission of bid that "as on date, no default has been made by us towards payment of GST and all returns up to the last date of submission of bid have been filed by us.'

2.6 DELIVERY TERMS:

The Tenderer should state the earliest possible delivery period for supply of stores. The delivery of the stores is required on f.o.r. destination basis. RSMML will place delivery schedule for the electrodes during the RC period as & when required basis

2.7 DELIVERY SCHEDULE:

Consignee will place delivery schedule for supply in advance by 21 days. However, tenderer will pre-pone the delivery in case of urgency. Tenderer will execute all delivery schedule placed within the contract period i.e. upto the last date of validity of contract.

RSMML reserves the right to alter/ modify the delivery schedule and the tenderer have to adhere to the same forthwith and shall effect the supplies of stores accordingly without any extra cost to the Company.

2.9 INSPECTION: The inspection shall be carried out at consignee's end after receipt of the material at site, which will be final and binding to the supplier. Annexure C: Grievance Redressal during Procurement Process

1) Filing an appeal

If any Bidder or prospective bidder is aggrieved that any decision, action or omission of the Procuring Entity is in contravention to the provisions of the Act or the Rules or the Guidelines issued thereunder, he may file an appeal to First Appellate Authority, as specified in the Bidding Document within a period of ten days from the date of such decision or action, omission, as the case may be clearly giving the specific ground or grounds on which he feels aggrieved:

Provided that after the declaration of a Bidder as successful the appeal may be filed only by a Bidder who has participated in the procurement proceedings:

Provided further that in case a Procuring Entity evaluates the technical bids before the opening of the financial Bids, an appeal related to the matter of Financial Bids may be filed only by a Bidder whose Technical Bid is found to be acceptable.

- 2) The officer to whom an appeal is filed under para (1) shall deal with the appeal as expeditiously as possible and shall endeavour to dispose it of within thirty days from the date of the appeal.
- 3) If the officer designated under para (1) fails to dispose of the appeal filed within the period specified in para (2) or if the Bidder or prospective bidder or the Procuring Entity is aggrieved by the order passed by the First Appellate Authority, the bidder or prospective bidder or the Procuring Entity, as the case may be, may file a second appeal to Second Appellate Authority specified in the Bidding Document in this behalf within fifteen days from the expiry of the period specified in para (2) or of the date of receipt of the order passed by the First Appellate Authority, as the case may be .

4) Appeal not to lie in certain cases

No appeal shall lie against any decision of the Procuring Entity relating to the following matters, namely:-

- a) Determination of need of procurement;
- b) Provisions limiting participation of Bidders in the Bid process;
- c) The decision of whether or not to enter into negotiations ;
- d) Cancellation of a procurement process;

e) Applicability of the provisions of confidentiality.

5) Form of Appeal

- a) An appeal under para (1) or (3) above shall be in the annexed form alongwith as many copies as there are respondents in the appeal;
- b) Every appeal shall be accompanied by an order appealed against, if any, affidavit verifying the facts stated in the appeal and proof of payment of fee.
- c) Every appeal may be presented to First Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority, as the case may be, in person or through registered post or authorized representative.

6) Fee for filing appeal

- a) Fee for the first appeal shall be rupees two thousand five hundred and for second appeal shall be rupees ten thousand, which shall be non-refundable.
- b) The fee shall be paid in the form of bank demand draft or bankers' cheque of a Scheduled Bank in India payable in the name of Appellate Authority concerned.

7) Procedure for disposal of appeal

- a) The First Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority, as the case may be, upon filing of appeal, shall issue notice accompanied by copy of appeal, affidavit and documents, if any, to the respondents and fix date of hearing.
- b) On the date fixed for hearing, the First Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority, as the case may be, shall –
 - (i) Hear all the parties to appeal present before him; and
 - (ii) Peruse or inspect documents, relevant records or copies thereof relating to the matter.
- c) After hearing the parties, perusal or inspection of documents and relevant records or copies thereof relating to the matter, the Appellate Authority concerned shall pass an order in writing and provide the copy of order to the parties to appeal free of cost.
- d) The order passed under sub-clause (c) above shall also be placed on the State Public Procurement Portal.

Annexure D : Additional Conditions of Contract

2. Correction of arithmetical errors

Provided that a Financial Bid is substantially responsive, the Procuring Entity will correct arithmetical errors during evaluation of Financial Bids on the following basis:

i) if there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected, unless in the opinion of the Procuring Entity there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected;

ii) If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of sub totals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and

iii) If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to (i) and (ii) above.

If the Bidder that submitted the lowest evaluated bid does not accept the correction of errors, its bid shall be disqualified and its Bid Security shall be forfeited or its Bid Securing Declaration shall be executed.

3. Procuring Entity's Right to Vary Quantities

(i) At the time of award of contract, the quantity of Goods, works or services originally specified in the Bidding Document may be increased or decreased by a specified percentage, but such increase or decrease shall not exceed twenty percent, of the quantity specified in the Bidding Document. It shall be without any change in the unit price or other terms and conditions of the bid and the conditions of contract.

(ii) If the Procuring Entity does not procure any subject matter of procurement or procures less than the quantity in the Bidding Document due to change in circumstances, the bidder shall not be entitled for any claim or compensation except otherwise provided in the conditions of contract.

(iii) In case of procurement of goods or services, additional quantity may be procured by extending the Rate Contract for a period of 3 months on the rates and conditions of the original Rate Contract. However, the additional quantity shall be in proportion to the original Rate Contract and shall be within one month from the date of expiry of last supply. If the supplier fails to do so, Procuring Entity shall be free to arrange for the balance supply by limited

bidding or otherwise and the extra cost incurred shall be recovered from the supplier.

4. Dividing quantities among more than one bidder at the time of award (In case of procurement of goods)

As a general rule all the quantities of the subject matter of procurement shall be procured from the bidder, whose bid is accepted. However, when it is considered that the quantity of the subject matter of procurement to be procured is very large and it may not be in the capacity of the bidder, whose bid is accepted, to deliver the entire quantity or when it is considered that the subject matter of procurement to be procured is of critical and vital nature, in such cases, the quantity may be divided between the bidder, whose bid is accepted and the second lowest bidder or even more bidders in that order, in a fair, transparent and equitable manner at the rates of the bidder, whose bid is accepted.
